
1984 VS 2024







Dr. Adena Williams Loston, Ph.D.

Dr. Adena Williams Loston serves as the 14th president of St. Philip's College, an HBCU and Hispanic-Serving Institution since March 1, 2007. Her oversight responsibilities include providing strategic leadership, collaborative partnerships and establishing and maintaining institutional effectiveness measures for multi-campuses with three military bases; the Port of Antonio Southwest Campus; the Good Samaritans Veterans Outreach and Transition Center; four Early College High Schools; and thirteen P-Techs for 14,000 students; an \$80M budget and \$20M grants and over \$500M in construction and renovation. She previously served as the Chief Education Officer for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration at its Headquarters in Washington, DC and directed policy for \$1.3 billion. She was responsible for the Educator Astronaut Program, NASA Explorer Schools and NASA Explorer Institutes; and the Director of Education and Special Assistant for Suborbital and Special Orbital Projects Directorate for the Goddard Space Flight Center at Wallops Flight Facility. She has served as president of San Jacinto College South; Executive Dean of Transmountain and Valle Verde Campuses in the El Paso Community College District; Dean of Professional Programs and Dean of Vocational Education, Budgets & Facilities at Santa Monica College (CA); Associate Professor at Georgia State University; Supervisor of Vocational Programs at Houston Community College and adjunct instructors at Texas Southern University and University of Houston-Downtown College. She possesses more than forty-five years of higher education experience and is committed to the advancement of education.

She is a recent Presidential Commission appointee to the Commission on Advancing Education Equity, Excellence and Economic Opportunity for Black Americans. She also serves as a member of the HBCU Title III Administrators Advisory Board; a member of the National Strada HBCU Advisory Council, an Advisory Trustee for the Southwest Research Institute, the KLRN Endowment Fund Board, the Alamo Colleges Collegiate Network Board, the Quality Texas Foundation Board of Directors and Presidents' Round Table. She previously served on the Boards of Directors for the San Antonio Area Foundation (three terms), a three-time appointee by the U. S. Secretary of Education to the HBCU Capital

Finance Advisory Committee. The Mayor's Commission on the Status of Women, the Eastside Promise Zone Coordinating Council and Eastside Promise Advisory Council, Mayor's SA2020 Board of Directors, Mayor's Commission on Teen Pregnancy, Alamo City Black Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, and SAGE (San Antonio for Growth on the Eastside) Board of Directors. She is a member of the San Antonio Women's Hall of Fame and has received numerous honors and awards with some including: NASA's Outstanding Medal of Leadership, Exceptional Achievement Medal and Group Achievement Awards for the Educator Astronaut and the NASA Explorer Schools; named Among The Ten Most Dominant HBCU Leaders in 2021; the Educator's Hall of Fame, the National Black College Alumni Hall of Fame Essential Leaders Award, Trusteed Leaders Award; 2023 Point of Light Award, After School All Stars Award, Kappa Alpha Psi Community Senior Leader Award, UNCF Excellence in Education Award, Les Dames d'Escoffier Legacy Award, Heard of Care Award, Alcorn's Women of Courage Award, History Makers Award, Leadership Legends Award,

Higher Education Legacy Award, NAACP Silver Lifetime



Membership Award, the Masons Community Builder Award, The Sankofa Institute for African American Pastoral Leadership Excellence in Education Award, the Brotherhood/Sisterhood Humanitarian Award and twice recipient of the Shirley B. Gordon International Presidential Award of Distinction.

She is a Life Member in the Alcorn State University National Alumni Association, a Life Member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. and a Life Member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP). Dr. Loston has established the Tommie Lee Williams Sr. Scholarship in honor of her father at Alcorn State University, the Dr. Adena Williams Loston Endowed Presidential Scholarship at St. Philip's College and HBCU, and the Dr. Adena Williams Loston Discretionary Scholarship Fund at St. Philip's College an HBCU.

Her educational background includes achieving a 1973 Alcorn State University B.S. Degree in Education. She received her Masters and Ph.D. degrees from Bowling Green State University in 1974 and 1979. She is the recipient of a 2005 Honorary Doctorate Degree in Science from Wiley University. Her additional professional development includes The Leadership Journey Wharton Business School 2005, the Oxford Round Table Oxford University Certificate 2001, and the Institute for Educational Management, Harvard University Certificate 1996.
